

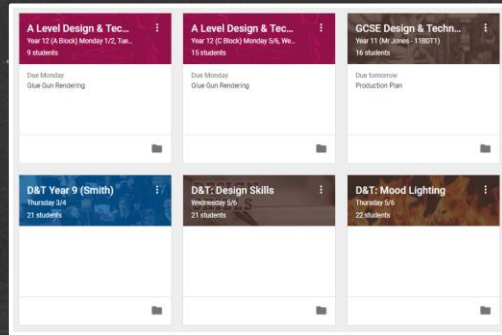
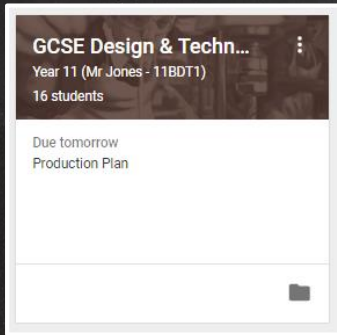

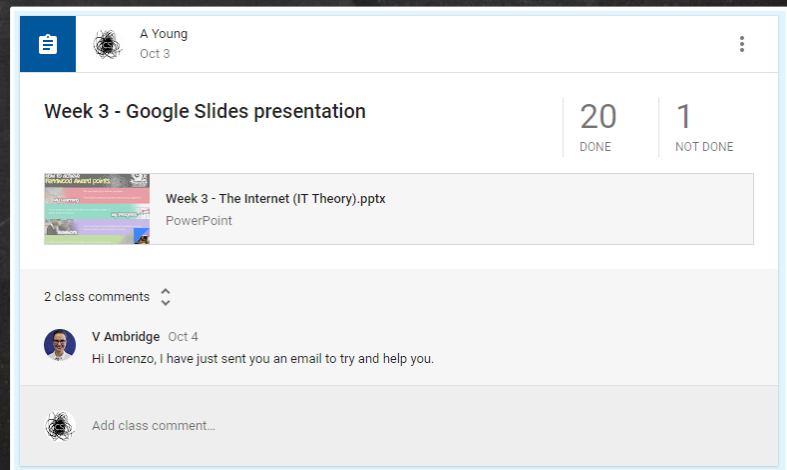


What is Classroom?



Your child will have a **'Google Class'** for each of their subjects on their timetable.

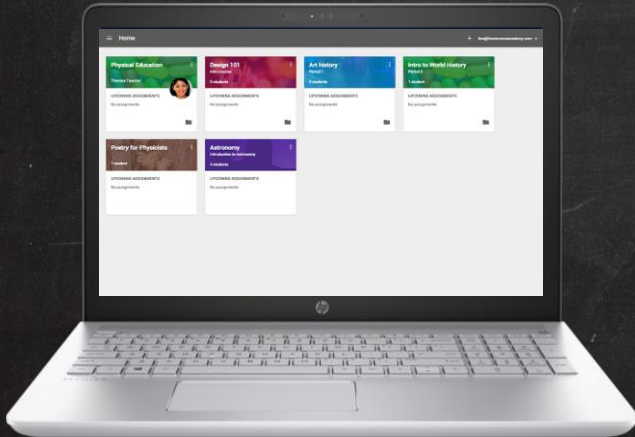
Teachers will post **homework assignments**, lesson resources and **exemplary work** onto the class feed for students to access from home (or wherever!).



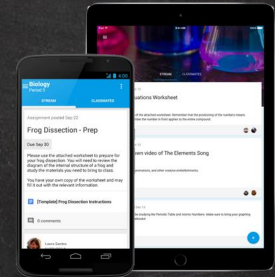
Benefits of Classroom



- Supporting **resources** to help with home learning
- Organisation - knowing **what is due when** (with reminders)
- Pupils gain **time to learn** in lessons, rather than wasting time writing down homework
- **Clarity** over what is being asked for each pupil

Daily/Weekly emails


Updating you on the homework that your child has coming up, and which they have completed (or not!).
